Review Stands: Located at Pershing Circle

Step off Time: 10:00 a.m. (MST)

Parade Route: Begins at Building 500, Pershing Road heading north turning left on Rhulen Road and heading up Historic Sheridan Road. Parade ends at Noel Parade Field where the annual Armed Forces Day Celebration will be located.

Anticipated Units: floats, marching bands, military vehicle convoys, military units, dignitaries and a wide variety of other special organizations.

Anticipated Crowd: Around 10,000 spectators

General Rules and Requirements

- 1. All Float, Band, ROTC, Community Organizations and Military Unit applications must attach a Liability Waiver at the time entry is submitted.
- 2. FMWR will review all applications. When your entry is approved and accepted, a signed copy of your application will be returned to you or you will be notified by phone.
- 3. Entries will be accepted based on the description included with your application. Upon arrival at the parade staging area, entries not conforming with the description on the application will not be allowed to participate in the parade. Any variance from the original application will not be accepted.
- 4. Any individual or group whose participation in the parade includes stunts or comedy antics, shall provide the FMWR with the details of such stunts at least 30 days prior to the date of the parade. No skits or maneuvers will be allowed which cause the parade to stop or deviate from the main direction of the parade travel.
- 5. During the parade, a distance of 50 feet is to be maintained between floats, bands, specialty units, etc. If halted for any reason, close the gaps to 25 feet, then take up the 50 ft. interval as the parade again moves. Everyone must cooperate if the parade gaps are to be eliminated. Please keep your group moving.
- 6. Participants must take and keep the spaces assigned to them throughout the parade all the way to the official disbanding areas. Each participant will receive a copy of your assigned position and instructions for parking, arrival times, and disbanding, approximately 4 days prior to the parade.
- 7. NO undecorated vehicles will be permitted in the parade.
- 8. All parade officials will be wearing identification and are assigned to specific divisions to assist participants with any problems along the parade route, and to maintain the parade's proper pace and spacing. Your participation and close observation of the regulations outlined herein will help make the Parade a successful event!

2019 Parade Float Entry Information Sheet

Describe your FLOAT(moving parts, costumes etc.):

Float guidelines

Fort Bliss Morale, Welfare and Recreation ("FMWR") has established rules and regulations to assist float builders in recognizing unsuspected errors that might impair an otherwise fine display of planning and workmanship. The overall condition of the float is very important. Long hours of hard work are defeated when an entry breaks down just before, or during the parade as a result of a mechanical problem or tire failure. Maximum height, width and length are limited to assure the proper clearance of obstacles such as overhead wires and cables, and the execution of changes of direction on the parade route. Please check your route to the parade assembly point for any existing hazards.

A final check will be made upon completion of the float, or at the assembly area on Parade Day.

THEMES: Individuals are able to select their own themes for their entries as long as they conform to family values and a family-friendly event atmosphere. Float entry applications are due no later than April 22, 2019. A color photograph of the float, or of the artwork, along with a written description of the float and sponsor information should be received along with the entry form. Please remember, we will not accept any political themes or politicians campaigning on any float. The Fort Bliss Armed Forces Day Parade is not a platform for political, social or religious issues. Entries are approved by the committee based on the "Entertainment value" to the overall parade. Entries must be submitted by April 22, 2019.

FLOAT DIMENSIONS: A float requires a base platform, or frame of not less than 8 x 10 feet. It must be decorated, including the sides, ends, and objects on the float, and must completely conceal the wheels. Flexible parts of the float aprons must reach to within 3" of the ground. The width the float upon completion is an important factor in the ground clearance. ALL FLOATS MUST BE SELF-PROPELLED. MOTORIZED UNITS (ie. cars, trucks, tractors) MUST BE USED TO MOVE THE FLOAT DOWN THE PARADE ROUTE. THE TOW VEHICLE MAY OR MAY NOT BE INCORPORATED INTO THE DESIGN OF THE FLOAT.

SIZE LIMITATIONS: Maximum height: 14 ft., 6 in. from the ground to highest point of float; Maximum width: 20 ft. Maximum length: 60 ft. all-inclusive.

DECORATIONS: All floats must be covered with sturdy materials such as vinyl floral sheeting, enamel paint, or other materials that will hold up under adverse weather conditions. Otherwise float decorations could be completely destroyed in the event of rain or strong winds. Floats shall be constructed and decorated so that the view from either side is equally appealing.

TITLE/SPONSOR RECOGNITION: The title of the float and the organization name should be displayed prominently on the float.

MUSIC: Your float should have music. However, please no live DJs, or live microphones will be permitted without permission from the Lora Diem, Special Events Coordinator. Questions? Call Lora at 915-588-8247.
