Some of the programs offered by the Fort Bliss Homeschool Association are:

Homeschool 101- Gives parents new to homeschooling more information on the FBHA and helps to answer questions regarding Texas homeschooling laws and other topics of interest to homeschool parents. Homeschool 101 is held the first Monday of each month at 6:00 PM at the Religious Activity Center located on old Fort Bliss.

Monthly field trips – The FBHA coordinates field trips for FBHA families to exciting places such as National Parks, hikes, the corn maze, museums, and the El Paso Zoo.
