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ABOUT THE COVER:

Fort Bliss Installation Commander Major General Curtis Taylor ceremonially taps a keg of German beer alongside German Schuhplattler dancers at Fort Bliss Oktoberfest.

Fun Fact: The ceremonial keg tapping is one of Oktoberfest's oldest and most cherished traditions. In Munich, the festival doesn't officially begin until the mayor drives a wooden tap into the first keg with a mallet, ideally in two strikes or fewer, then shouts "O'zapft is!" ("It's tapped!"). Only then can the beer start flowing. The tradition dates back to the early 1950s and has become the symbolic starting gun for Oktoberfest celebrations around the world, including here at Fort Bliss. 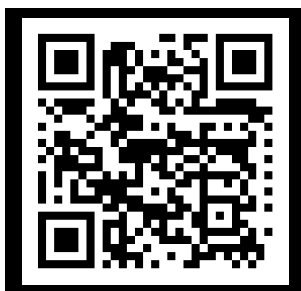

Honoring the Past, Welcoming the Future: Pershing Pub at Pace Hall

After months of meticulous restoration, Pershing Pub at historic Pace Hall has reopened its doors, unveiling a beautifully reimagined space where Fort Bliss' rich history meets modern hospitality. The extensive renovation preserves the building's historic character while introducing thoughtful updates, ensuring this treasured landmark will continue serving Soldiers, families, retirees, civilians, and guests for generations to come.

The project, initiated by Project Manager Candice Rice in December 2025, was driven by a shared commitment to preserving one of Fort Bliss' most significant historic buildings. What began as a renovation quickly became a collaborative effort dedicated to protecting the building's legacy.

"This project was a melting of different expertise, a collaboration of craftsmen, architects and preservationists," said Fort Bliss Historian Troy Ainsworth.

Every phase of the renovation focused on maintaining the building's original character. The historic living quarters were restored keeping the original marble showers and tile in the bathrooms, carpet removed to unveil the beautiful original wood flooring, and the exterior received fresh historically accurate paint while preserving many of the architectural features that define Pace Hall, such as the original light fixtures and historic shutters. Restoration crews even uncovered original wallpaper hidden beneath layers of previous renovations in one of the restrooms, a remarkable glimpse into the building's past.

Preservation Specialist Donald Seigny described the philosophy behind the project as creating "function with purpose in order to commemorate a part of Fort Bliss history." That vision guided every decision, ensuring the building remains both historically authentic and functional for today's community.

Pace Hall also tells the story of Lt. Pace, a 1940 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point who was killed in action in the Philippines in 1942 during World War II. His sacrifice lives on through the building that bears his name. The venue also honors the enduring legacy of General John J. Pershing, whose leadership and service remain deeply connected to the history of Fort Bliss.

Now elegantly restored, Pershing Pub at Pace Hall accommodates up to 75 guests in a refined setting that blends timeless architectural character with contemporary amenities. Whether hosting receptions, unit functions, meetings, or special celebrations, the venue offers an intimate atmosphere unlike any other on the installation.

While the renovations have transformed the building, its purpose remains rooted in connection. The team behind the project hopes Pershing Pub at Pace Hall will become more than a beautifully restored event venue, they envision it as a gathering place where the Fort Bliss community can come together while also learning about the lives and legacies of Lt. Pace and General Pershing.

By preserving the stories behind the walls as carefully as the building itself, Pershing Pub at Pace Hall ensures that history is not simply remembered but experienced. 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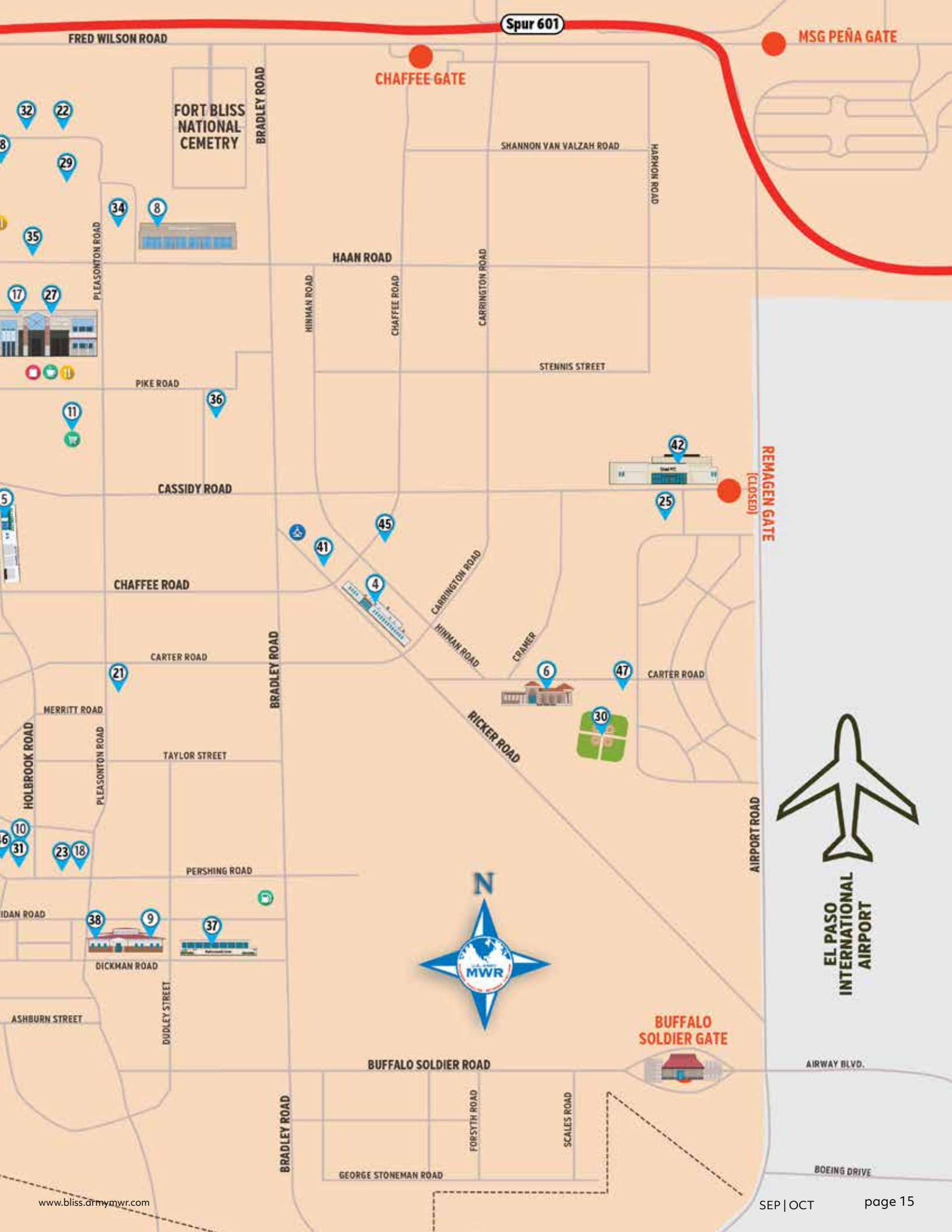
