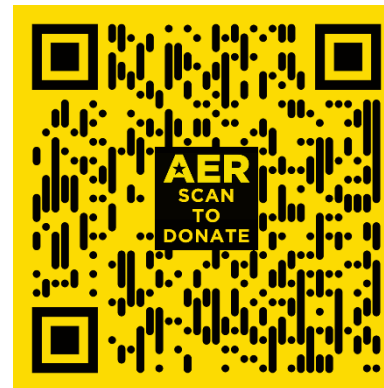
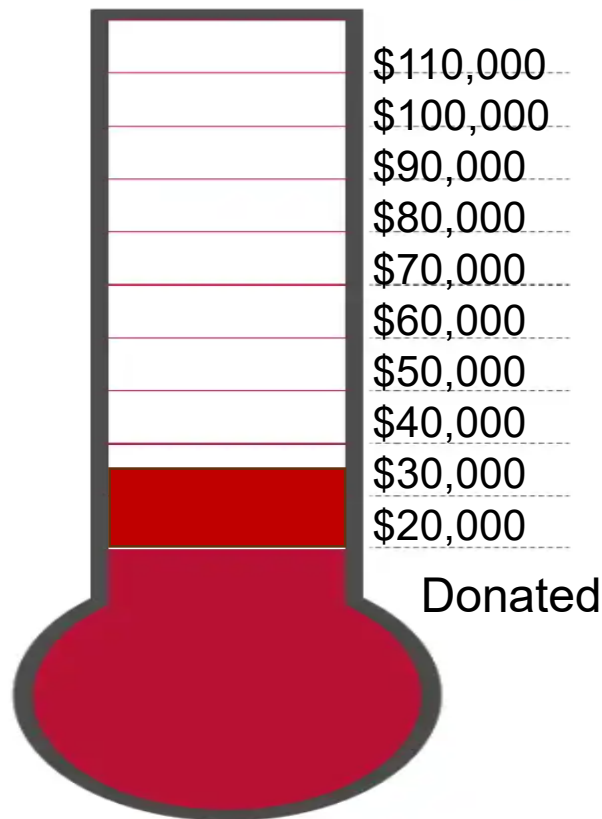

- TRICARE - New regional contractor, TriWest Healthcare Alliance at 888-TRIWEST (888-874-9378). A temporary waiver for pre-authorization of referrals in the West Region has been extended from January 1 to April 30, 2025. This means that once you have a referral from your primary care manager, you can proceed directly to any TRICARE-authorized specialty provider without waiting for TriWest's approval. 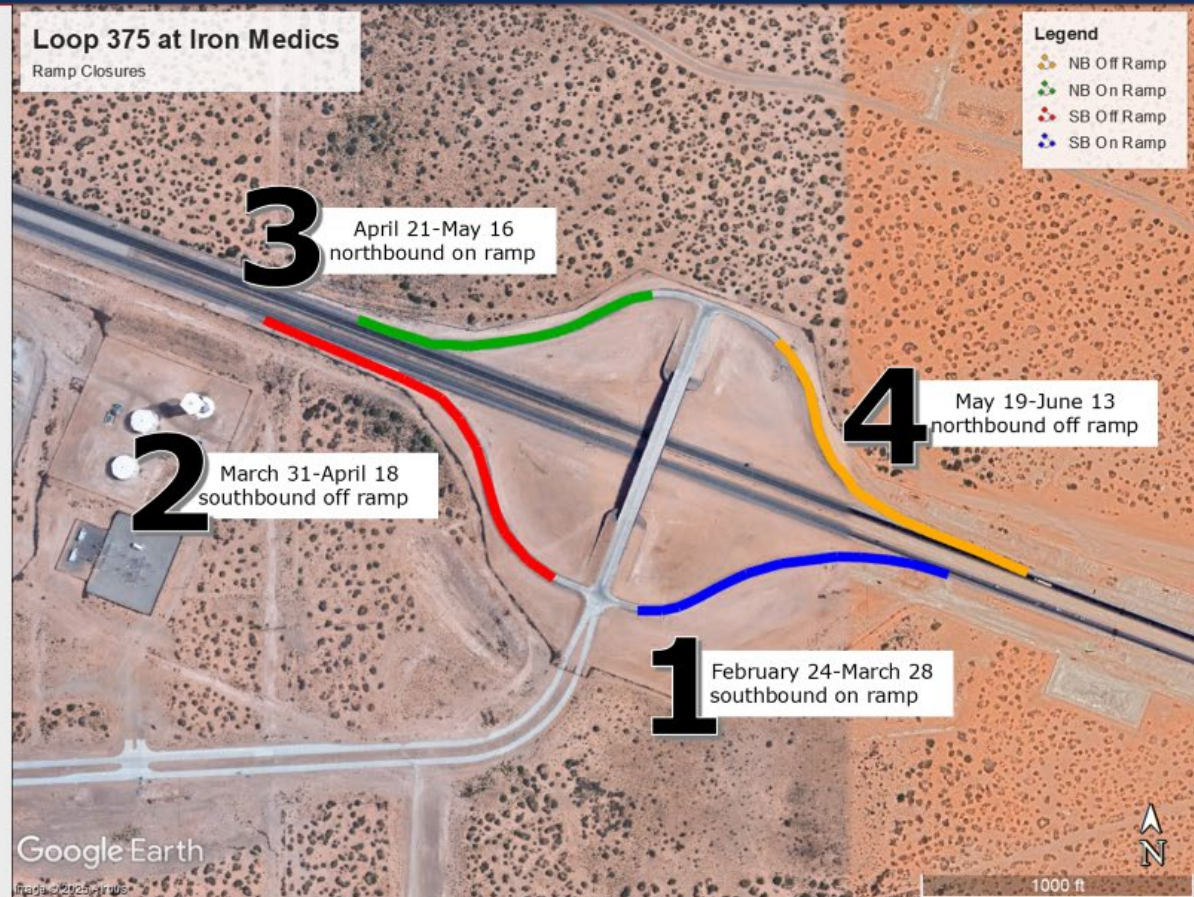
Scheduled Ramp Closures!

- Crews on the Purple Heart Widening Project will begin work on the Iron Medics ramps.
- Each on and off ramp will each be closed for about one month beginning with the southbound on ramp.
- The closure is needed so crews can construct connections to the future frontage roads.
- Drivers should plan access via the alternate ramps and Spur 601 turnarounds to access Loop 375.

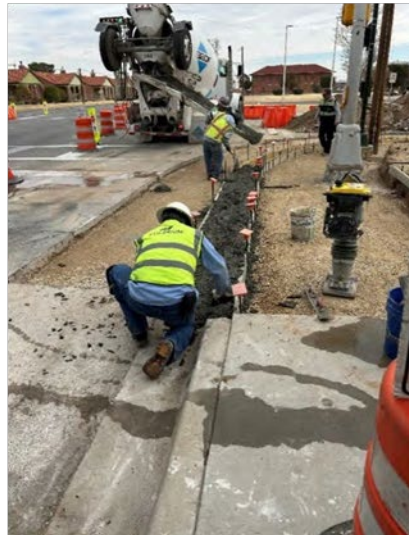

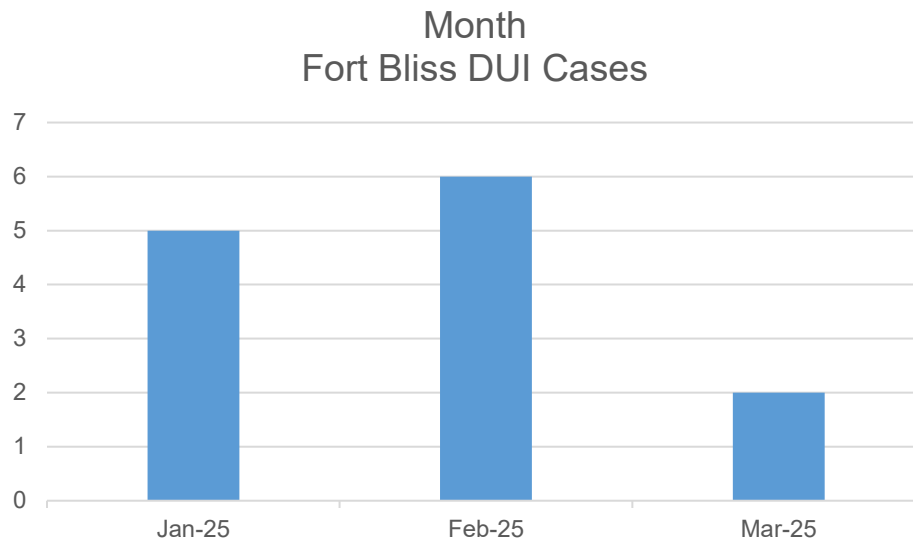

Police Services Division

- Fort Bliss DUIs – Decreased by four in March 2025
 - Soldier presence is reduced on Fort Bliss by 1 AD deployment activities from February
 - Fort Bliss Police transfers all civilian DUI subjects arrived at ACPs to El Paso Police Department and interested law enforcement agencies

Physical Security Division

- FORSCOM Ride Share Pilot Program 1 March – 1 June 2025.
 - To reduce delays, **reduce DWI's**, synergize access process, and develop standard across all installations.
- Uber Ride Share currently has 115 drivers who are vetted for installation access under this program and authorized 24/7 access.
- Geo-Fencing: Fort Bliss has provided geo-fencing information to Uber so that all calls received for on post pick up, or drop off, will receive a vetted driver reducing delays, or turn arounds at the ACPs.
- Lyft did not participate in this program.
- Over 750 Food delivery drivers cleared for access, but not geo-fenced and not currently part of the pilot program.

Directorate of Emergency Services

Physical Security Division

- **ACCESS DENIAL NCIC:** Non-DoD guests and visitors who attempted to obtain a pass but were denied access due to having a felony in NCIC, cannot obtain an unescorted access pass but can obtain an escorted access pass with a DoD ID holder. Can request waiver to obtain unescorted access pass.
- **ACCESS DENIAL BAR:** Non-DoD guests who have a BAR to any federal installation may not have unescorted or escorted access. Can request waiver to senior commander to authorize access to Fort Bliss.
- Unofficial Foreign National visitors requesting access to Fort Bliss must be sponsored and escorted by DoD personnel (with valid DoD issued identification)
- Ride Share Drivers have been experiencing access issues. DES is working with Ride Share and food Delivery services to ensure they are properly vetted and allowed 24/7 access.
