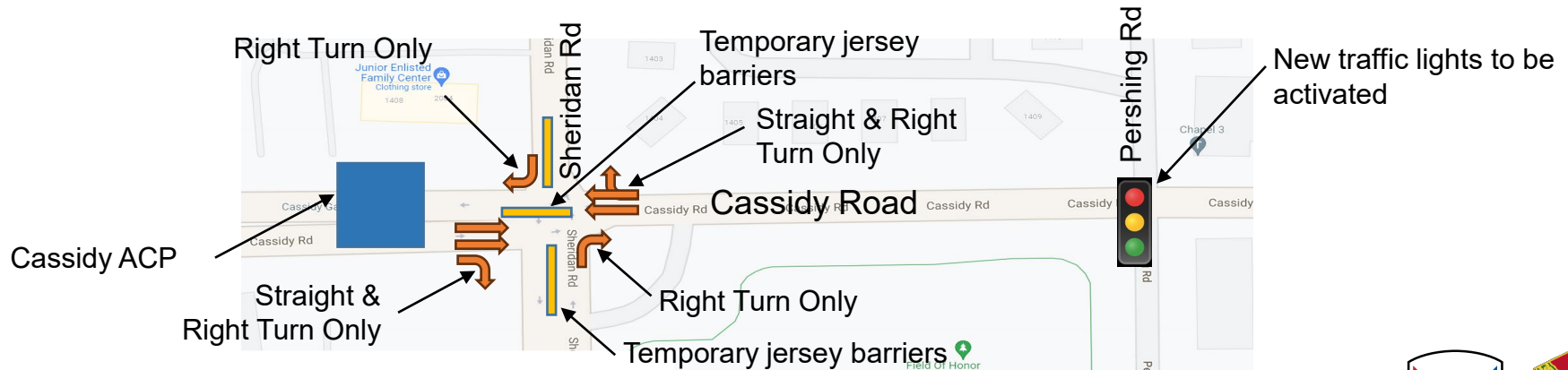

Directorate of Public Works (DPW) Road Repair Update

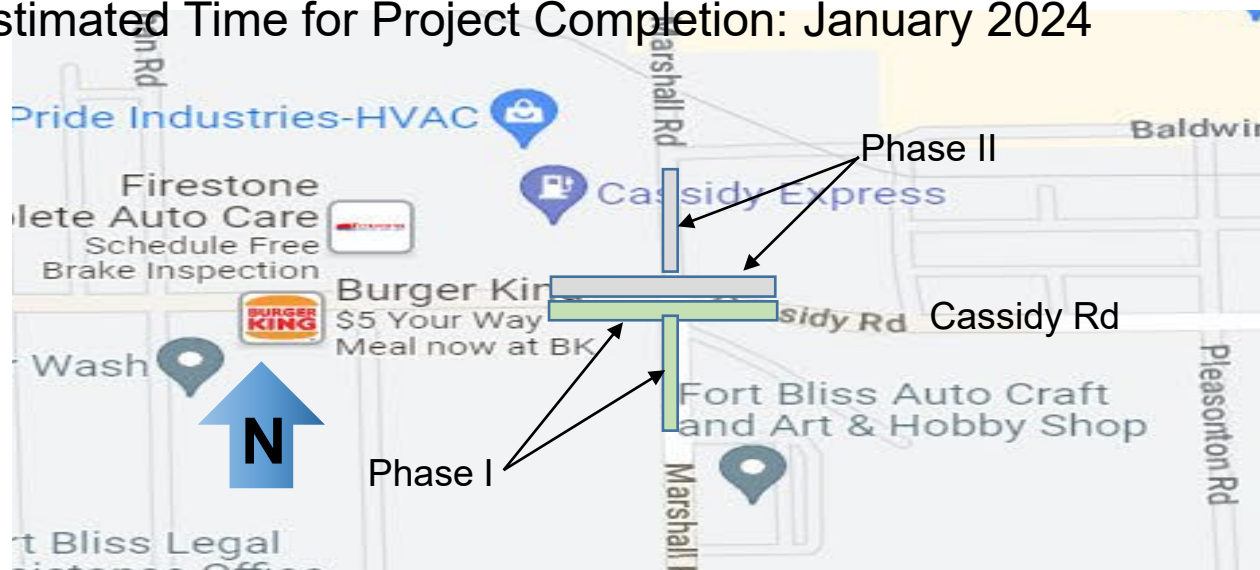
➤ **Temporary Modifications at Cassidy/Sheridan and Cassidy/Pershing Intersection:**

- Vehicles traveling east/west on Cassidy Rd will always have a traffic green light unless a pedestrian crosswalk signal is activated. Vehicles traveling on Cassidy Rd will be able to turn right onto Sheridan Rd.
- Vehicles traveling north/south on Sheridan Rd. will only be allowed to turn right onto Cassidy Rd. Sheridan Rd traffic light will always remain red.
- DPW will be utilizing temporary jersey barriers and signs on Cassidy/Sheridan Intersection while permanent traffic devices are installed in FY24.
- Cassidy/Pershing traffic light to be activated after Cassidy/Sheridan intersection temporary modifications are completed.
- Estimated Period of Completion for temporary intersection modifications: 6 October 2023.
- Permanent modifications to intersection to be worked in FY24, completion date: TBD



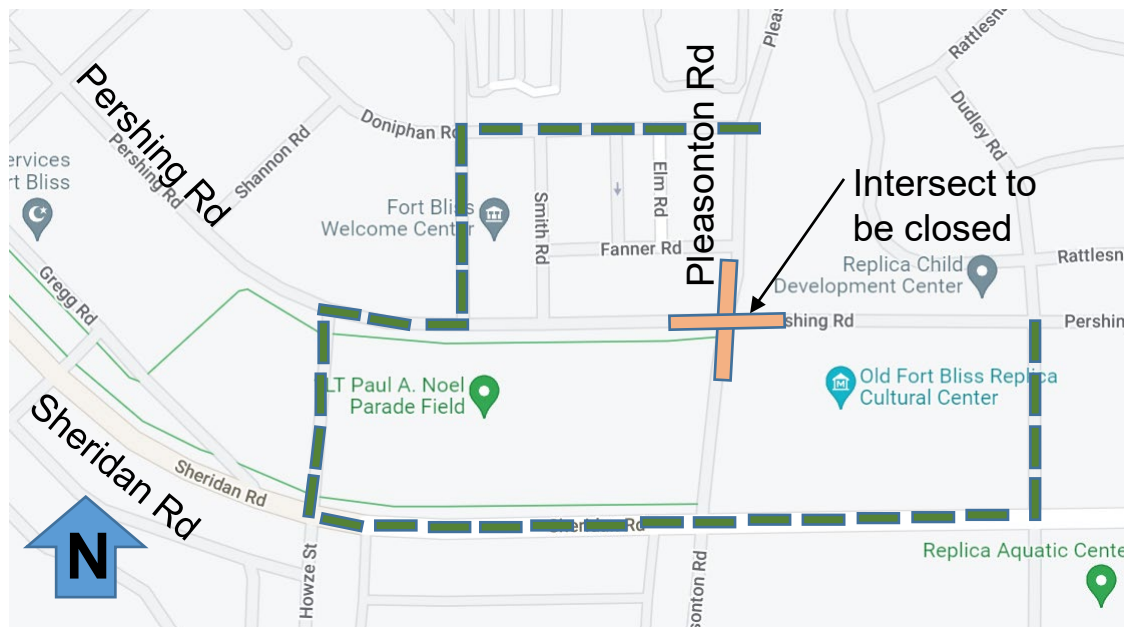
➤ Cassidy and Marshall Intersection Paving Repairs

- Due to unforeseen existing utility lines, Corps of Engineers will not be able to complete the project as designed. The Contractor will be allowed to complete a full utility survey, restore the pavement to its original condition, and reopen the intersection on all directions.
- Phase I lanes to be reopened tentatively 3rd week of October 2023. Phase II lanes will be closed tentatively right after the 3rd week of October. More to follow on accurate dates once the Corps of Engineers receives the revised construction schedule from Contractor.
- Estimated Time for Project Completion: January 2024



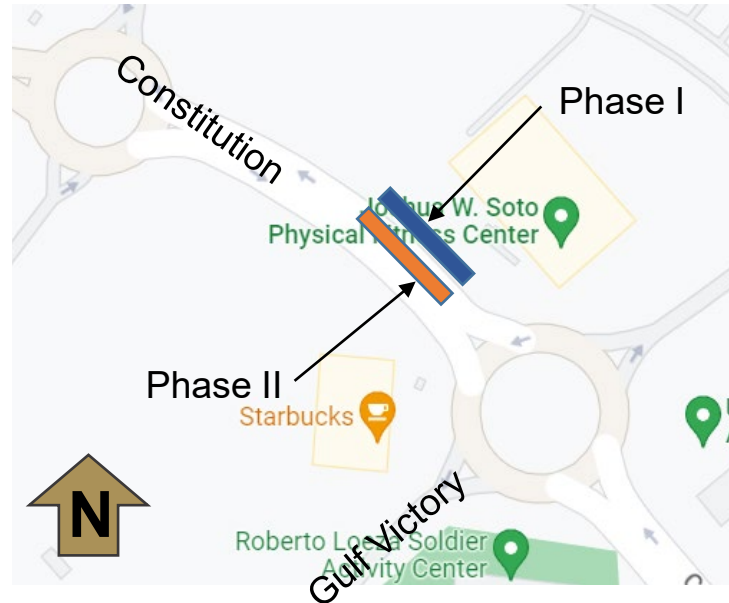
➤ Water Mitigation at Pershing & Pleasonton Intersection

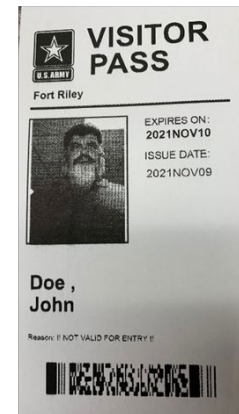
(New) Fort Bliss Guest Access Pass Online/Kiosk

To obtain a **Guest Access Pass**, visitors can pre-register on the Visitor Management System website https://pass.aie.army.mil/?b=usa&i=fort_bliss&t=v, or go directly to a kiosk located at either Buffalo Soldier or Chaffee Visitor Control Center.



You may choose from one of the following reasons for the visit:
