Army Emergency Relief AER Career Skills Program (CSP) Assistance

 Purpose: CSP allows retiring and separating Soldiers to participate in skills training during their transitional period to improve their civilian employment options.

RFI IFF

10 DEC 21

EST. 1942

- Assistance can include: Funding for purchase of business attire/uniforms, tools, travel expenses, lodging, and basic living expenses either before, during, or after CSP program. All assistance will be provided before ETS/Retirement date.
- Assistance offered as 100% grant: \$500 cap for local CSP programs, \$1,000 cap for Permissive TDY programs, \$1,500 cap for OCONUS to CONUS CSP programs.

Process:

U.S.ARMY

- Soldier works closely with the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) CSP team at Fort Bliss.
- TAP verifies enrollment and expenses needed to attend CSP.
- Soldier submits AER request with Fort Bliss AER office.




The ACS Hiring Fair

State Advisory Council (HB 3932)

• Established the State Advisory Council on Educational Opportunity for Military Children.

• ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

• Will increase coordination among state agencies, school districts, and military installations concerning the state's participation in and compliance with Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Child.

State Advisory Council Committee Members

- The Council will consist of 11 or more members to oversee the Interstate Compact and participate in the Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission (MIC3).
- Roles of the State Advisory Council
- The council may recommend policy concerning operations and procedures of the Interstate Compact within the state.
- The council will help increase knowledge of the Interstate Compact requirements for local education agencies, thereby increasing education success for military-connected students.

- > The holiday season is a historically low collection time for our organization.
 - Fort Bliss Blood donor center is desperate for <u>Command Support</u> for blood drives.
 - > <u>PLEASE</u> host a blood drive during block leave (Dec 20-22 & 27-29)
 - We need at least 20 donors each on those days to make mission over the holiday season
 - We still need to support those troops who are conducting combat operations.
 - Troops who are away from their families during the holidays still need our support.
- Afghanistan and Korea (N. of Seoul) are now 3 month deferral instead of 12 months.
- ASBP is still in need of Convalescent Plasma Donors (with confirmed positive test result).


