








Road Repairs at Torch & B21227






Road Repairs at Minue & Torch




Road Repairs at Cassidy and Marshall






Water Line Installation Traffic Control Plan

Fort Bliss Community Access Pass

- Personnel not affiliated with Fort Bliss can obtain a three-year community access pass after passing a criminal history background check at VCCs.
- Pass allows the public access to Fort Bliss through any open ACP 0600-2200.
- To receive pass, visitors are required to use Real-ID compliant driver's license or stateissued identification card.
- Visitors can convert their current "Recreational Pass" into a Community Access Pass.


