

#### **Alternative Tax Preparation Sources:**

- ✓ All Soldiers are strongly encouraged to use Military OneSource to prepare their taxes. Military OneSource is a confidential Department of Defense funded program that is both a call center and a website providing comprehensive information on every aspect of military life at no cost to Active Duty, Guard and Reserve Component members, their families and survivors. For more information, visit WWW.MILITARYONESOURCE.MIL/MILTAX-FREE-TAX-SERVICES.
- ✓ Individuals who are not eligible to use Military OneSource to prepare their taxes may use the free filing services provided by the IRS. Please keep in mind that these free filing services have certain income thresholds. - ✓ TaxSlayer has a military offer that allows active-duty military to e-file a federal return for free. Please note that State returns have an additional cost. - ✓ Those who do not qualify for free filing will have to purchase a commercial tax preparation software or hire a commercial preparer to file their taxes.

NOTE: Although the Fort Bliss Legal Assistance Office will no longer provide tax preparation and filing services, it will continue to provide advice and assistance on certain tax issues, such as reviewing letters from the IRS or state tax authorities, as part of legal assistance.
