








Cassidy/Sheridan and Cassidy/Pershing Intersection

- New Traffic Signals to be installed at Cassidy and Pershing






Road Repairs at Torch & Bridge [No Change]

Law Enforcement Focus Areas

Increased Traffic Enforcement:

- Police Services Divisions (PSD) has increased their focus on traffic violations across
 the installation since the end of April. As part of this effort to reduce traffic violations
 PSD has increased MP presence in the Brigade footprints during physical readiness
 training hours. Additionally, we have increased our presence on West Bliss,
 specifically the Cassidy and Sheridan road area during lunch and the end of the
 duty day.
- Since the beginning of May the MPs have issued 49 traffic citations and 16 written warnings. We anticipate that by the end of May we will have a firm grasp on the trends as they relate to traffic violations and make adjustments as necessary.
