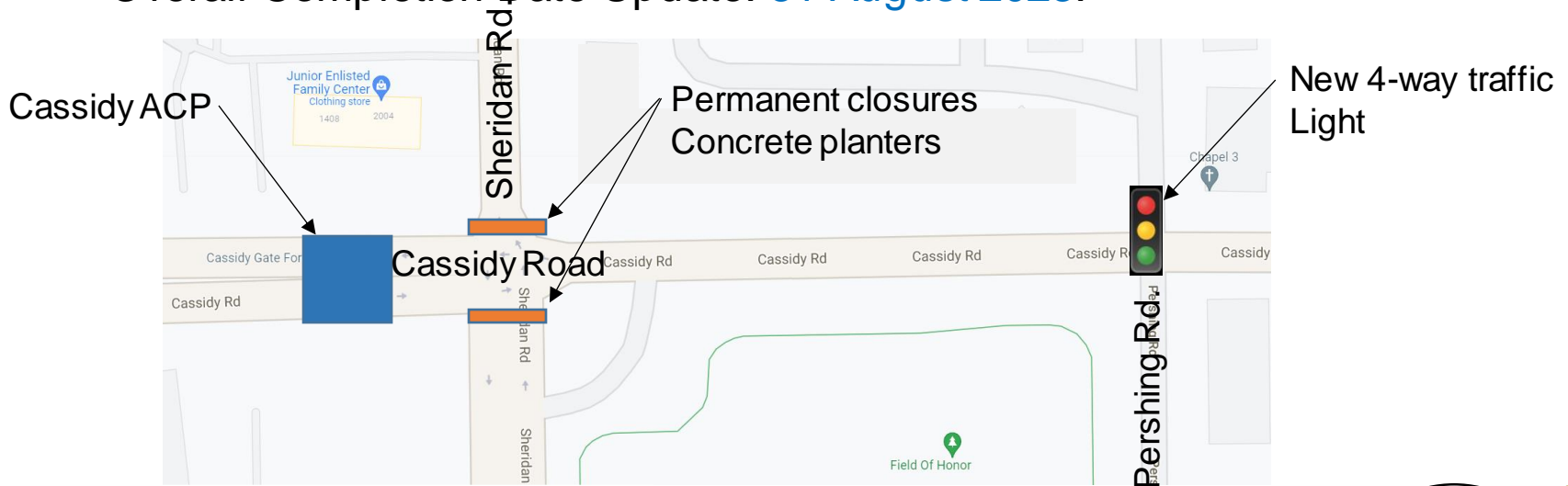

- Overall Completion Date Update: **31 August 2023.**



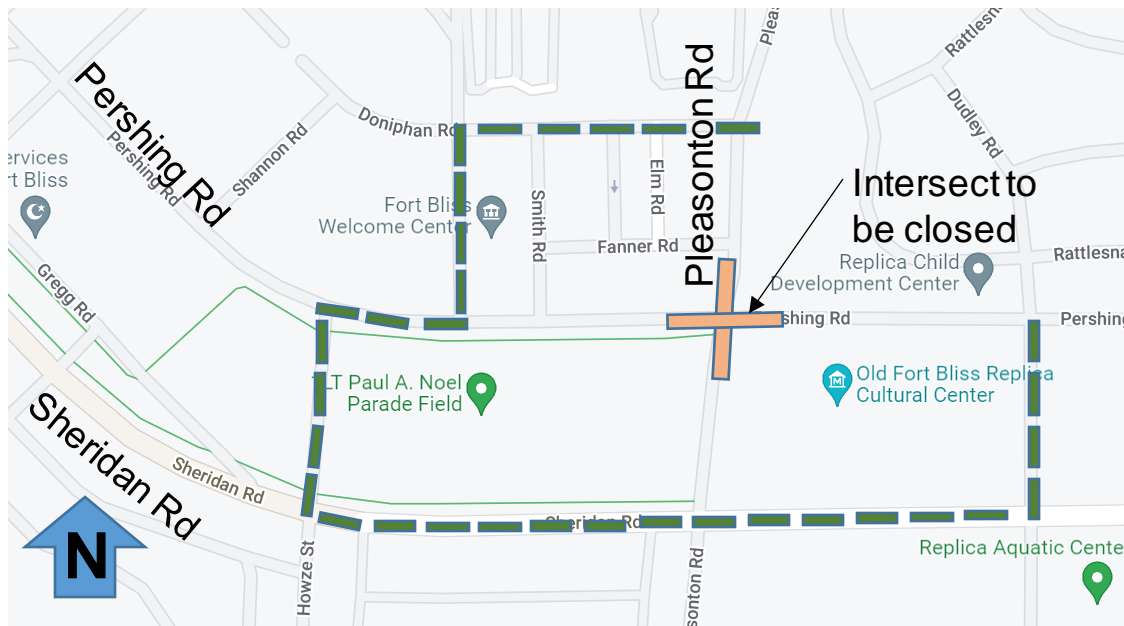

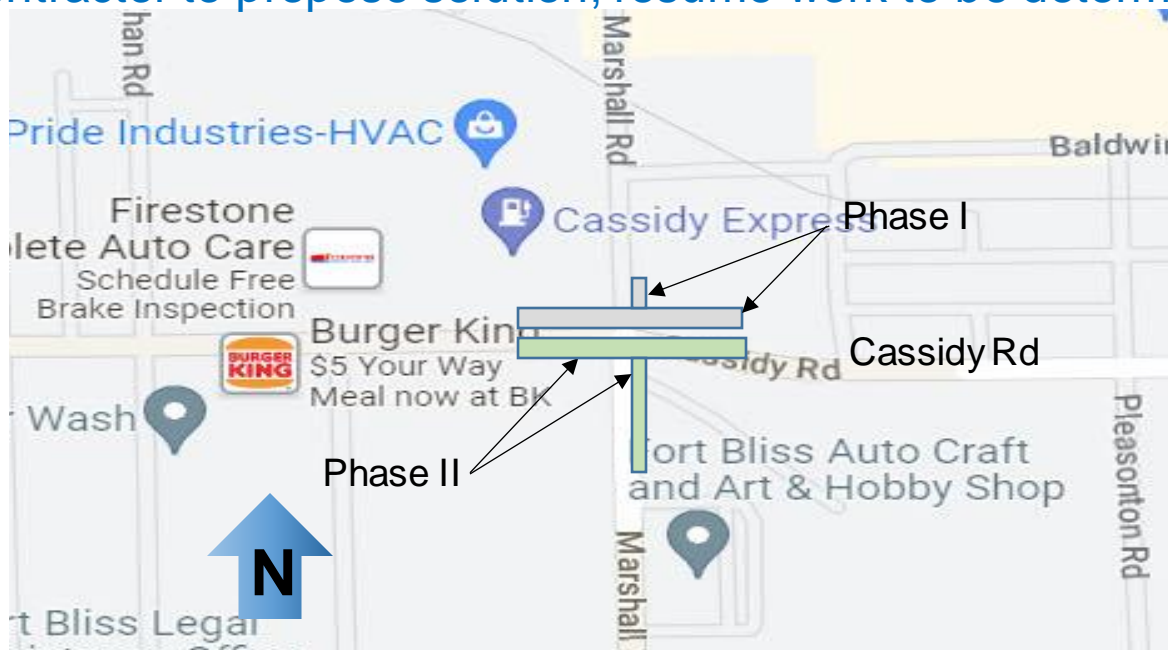
- **Water Mitigation at Pershing & Pleasonton Intersection**

  - Completion Date Update: **30 Nov 2023**



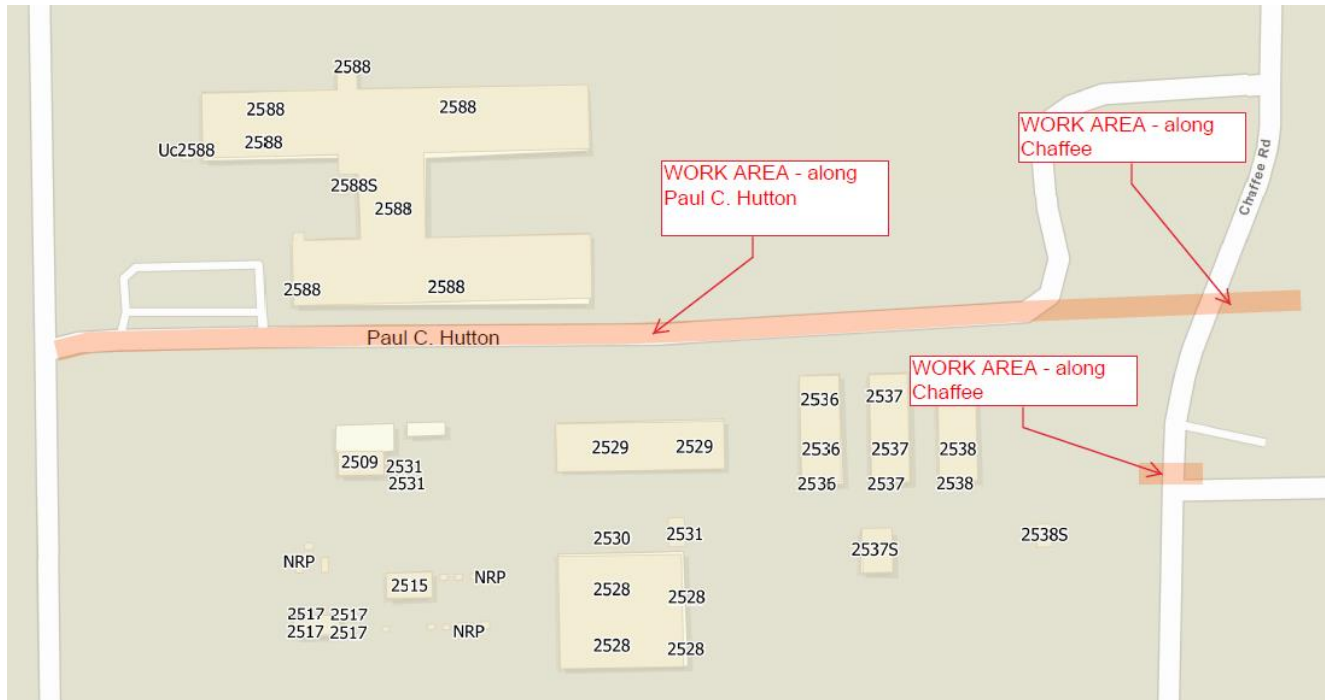

## Road Repair Update

- **Cassidy and Marshall Intersection Paving Repairs**
  - Construction started: 3 April 2023
  - Project Phases I and II: Two Way Traffic, One Lane in Each Direction
  - Phase II Start Date: 20 September 2023
  - Completion Date: 28 December 2023. **Update: Construction delay due to unforeseen underground utilities. USACE is working with the contractor to propose solution, resume work to be determined.**



- **2500 Area Waterline Replacement – Work Area Notification**
  - **Location:** 2500 Area, along Paul C. Hutton crossing Chaffee.
  - **Road Impacts:** None expected
  - **Begin Construction:** June 2023
  - **End Construction:** February 2024



# Directorate of Emergency Services

## Law Enforcement Focus Area

- **Increased Traffic Enforcement:**

- Police Services Divisions (PSD) is continuing to maintain their focus on traffic violations across the installation, with special focus on housing areas both contiguous and non-contiguous. Furthermore, PSD is focusing on the BDE footprints during PT hours and the high traffic areas during the lunch hours as well as the end of the duty day. The intent for increasing the focus on safety-related moving violations is to increase public safety. We believe the focus within the housing areas will increase driver awareness to posted speed limits and traffic control signs, especially now that the school year is ending. Ultimately this initiative will increase the safety on the Fort Bliss roadways.
- Since the beginning of May, MPs have issued a total of 301 traffic citations and 51 warning tickets. We anticipate that these efforts by PSD will lead to a steady decrease of traffic violations in the month of June.

- **93d MP BN South West Border Support:**

- No impact to Law Enforcement operations within the installation.
- The DES team continues to monitor the installation security conditions for changes.

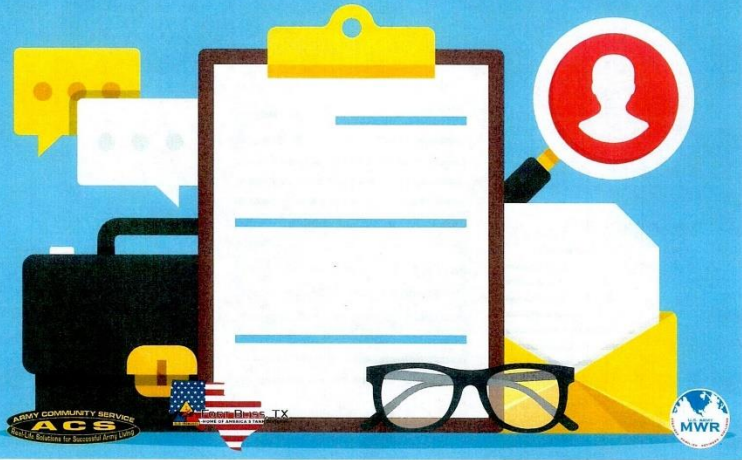
