



- Completion Date Update: 30 Nov 2023







# **Directorate of Emergency Services**

### Law Enforcement Focus Area

### **Increased Traffic Enforcement:**

- Police Services Divisions (PSD) is continuing to maintain their focus on traffic violations across the installation, with special focus on housing areas both contiguous and noncontiguous. Furthermore, PSD is focusing on the BDE footprints during PT hours and the high traffic areas during the lunch hours as well as the end of the duty day. The intent for increasing the focus on safety-related moving violations is to increase public safety. We believe the focus within the housing areas will increase driver awareness to posted speed limits and traffic control signs, especially now that the school year is ending. Ultimately this initiative will increase the safety on the Fort Bliss roadways.
- Since the beginning of May, MPs have issued a total of 301 traffic citations and 51 warning tickets. We anticipate that these efforts by PSD will lead to a steady decrease of traffic violations in the month of June.
