#### IMPACT AID & MILITARY CONNECTED STUDENTS

• Impact Aid is a federal program that provides funding for a portion of the educational cost of federal-connected students. It recaptures money lost from federal land located within the districts' boundaries that is exempt from property taxes (up to \$3000 per student).

#### IMPACT AID FUNDING

- School district's Impact Aid payments are based in part on the count of federally connected including military children who attend schools in the district. The money is not designated for individual children.
- HOW IMPACT AID SUPPORTS MILITARY STUDENTS
- Impact Aid is the only federal education program where funds are sent directly to the school districts. The funds go directly into the school district's general fund for operations such as the purchase of textbooks, computers, utilities, and payment of staff salaries. It helps offset the cost to educate students who live on exempt property.

#### IMPORTANCE OF RETURNING THE IMPACT AID FORM

• Every year, schools send home an Impact Aid form or an online survey for parents to complete, sign and return. This form counts the number of federally impacted students in the school district to apply for available money. Schools send this survey home anytime from the fourth day of school to January 31.

#### Are you ready for ArmylgnitED 2.0? Mark 26 August 2022 on Your Calendars

Your Army Continuing Education Center stands ready to help with the transition and actions required to ensure Tuition Assistance is processed for past dated courses through courses with a start date not later than 30 September 2022.

- 26 August 2022: All FY22 Tuition Assistance Requests (TARs) submitted and approved, this includes any course start dates beginning 27 August 2022 through 30 September 2022. If your Education Institution (EI) has not uploaded your course enrollment files, request that your EI upload course enrollment files to ArmylgnitED "1.0". No FY22 TARs will be approved after 26 August 2022 in ArmylgnitED "1.0".
- 26 August 2022: All past dated FY21 and FY22 Exception to Policy (ETP) TARs for courses from 8 February 2021 to date that require the blanket ETP TAR must be processed by the Soldier in ArmylgnitED "1.0". Course enrollment files must be uploaded by EIs and Soldiers must request TA for these courses by 26 August 2022. *Reminder,* this draw is different from the rest and requires the Soldier to request TA for past-dated enrollments. Those enrollments are no longer automatically generated into TARs on the Soldier's behalf.
- FY23 TARs will be processed in ArmylgnitED 2.0 for all courses with a start date of 1 October 2022 and later.


