Students in the Dual Language Program will need a pencil sharpener with a lid.

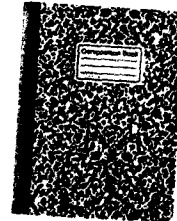

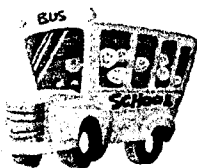
