



The best way to activate your script and save a trip, is by using the Tricare Online Patient Portal to select your new medications to be filled. This brand-new technology allows for activation whether they come from your William Beaumont Provider OR from your network provider. Prescriptions activated online have a 24-hour turn-around time. Requests received after 1600 will be received the following business day and processed as such (i.e. A prescription request that is submitted at 1630 on a Wednesday will be ready for pickup when that pharmacy opens on Friday). If you do not have access to a computer or smartphone and cannot utilize this technology, you can utilize in-person activation* or ask your William Beaumont provider to send an email to activate the prescription for you.

*In-person activation will require a second, return trip to pick up for non-acute medications.



HOURS: Monday – Saturday 0800-1200. Closed Sundays, Federal Holidays and Fort Bliss DONSA.







- C** Clinic Entrance





Holiday Lighting and Decorations

BBC – Reminders !

- Lighted seasonal decorations on the exterior of the home may be used between the hours of 1800-2300 only from the week after Thanksgiving through New Year's Day (they should not remain on during the day or all night)
- Seasonal decorations must be removed no later than the third week of January
- Outdoor decorations for other holidays (Halloween, Easter, Fourth of July, etc.) must be removed no later than the third week after the holiday
- Rooftop and second story level decorations are prohibited
- Decoration materials must be fire resistant
- Nails, spikes, building staples or any other type of fastener that leaves permanent damage are prohibited
- All lights and fixtures must be listed or labeled by a nationally recognized testing agent for indoor or outdoor use as applicable
- Lining sidewalks with lights is prohibited
- Candle luminaries or other open flame decorations are prohibited
- Do not use indoor extension cords for outdoors
- Canned 'snow' and similar substances are not permitted to be sprayed on windows, siding or brick facades
