- WHERE:** Centennial Banquet & Conference Center 11199 Sergeant E. Churchill St.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Active-duty military personnel, Army Reserve, and National Guard service members in an active status assigned or attached to Fort Bliss.
- REGISTRATION:** Pickup registration packets at the Sports Office located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Soto Physical Fitness Center. Completed packets may be submitted at the Sports Office up until 04 March 2026 / 1300.
- All other completed packets must be submitted at weigh-ins, 05 March 2026 at The Centennial / 0900 – 1300.
- Weigh-Ins** will take place at The Centennial in the Ultima Room 05 March 2026 / 0900 – 1300. All forms must be turned in at this time.
- REQUIRED FORMS:**
1. Registration/Sworn Statement
  2. Sports Physical
  2. Liability Waiver (signed by 1SG/CDR)
- COMPETITION  
FORMAT:** Each bout will consist of three 1-minute rounds, with 1-minute in between rounds. Competitors will be matched based on weight class.
- DIVISIONS:**
- MALE** (11 Wt. Classes): 108lbs, 114lbs, 123lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 201lbs, 201+lbs.
- FEMALE** (11 Wt. Classes): 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 178+lbs.

**EQUIPMENT:**

The MWR Sports Office will provide the following equipment:

**AWARDS:**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place individual awards for each bout.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:**

**Swearing and abusive remarks:** Whether directed towards opponents, team members, officials, fans or supervisors or indirect frustration about self-performance are behaviors which cast a negative atmosphere over intramural play and may lead to more serious problems.

Any contest may be forfeited by the administrator or official of the activity when a competitor or coach exhibits unsportsmanlike conduct or disruptive behavior during the contest. Competitors or coaches may be warned prior to forfeiting the contests. However, it will be at the discretion of the administrators to forfeit that contest if deemed necessary to avoid a violent confrontation. Competitors/Coaches ejected for a first offense may be suspended indefinitely from participating in sports activities, depending on the severity of the offense.

**ALCOHOL/TOBACCO:**

Alcohol, smoking, vaping, or use of chewing tobacco is not permitted in the facility. Any competitor or coach under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted to enter the playing area.

**MEDICAL SUPPORT:**

Medical coverage will be provided.

**COACHES MEETING:**
