

- The 1st Calvary Division's association with Fort Bliss was the longest of any unit in Fort Bliss history.
- Their time ended when they turned in their horses and left for the Pacific Theater in the summer of 1943.







Did you know?



- ✓ The Pershing Home on Fort Bliss was built in 1910. General of the Armies John J. "Black Jack" Pershing lived in the home at 228 Sheridan Road from 1914 to 1916 as then post commander.
- ✓ In October 1911, the Pershing House was the scene of a historic event: The first 48-star flag was raised in front of the quarters to celebrate the pending statehood of neighboring New Mexico and Arizona.
- ✓ The cost to build the original Pershing House was \$16,000.





- Contact tracing will continue for COVID-19 exposures


Strategic planning for learning loss intervention

By hiking or biking any trail in the mountains you will be entering into Franklin Mountains State Park. To enter the state park, you **MUST have a permit** (day pass) that you can get online:

https://texasstateparks.reserveamerica.com/

You can also get the permit at the park's Visitor Center located at 2900 Tom Mays Access Road, El Paso, TX 79911

Office hours 8-4 pm daily, phone 915-444-9100.

For your own safety and the preservation of our fragile desert, always **stay on the trail**. A large percentage of search and rescue incidents occur because people decided to hike off trail. Severe trail damage and soil erosion has been caused by people hiking off trail.

Stay off Castner Range due to possible unexploded ordnance (UXOs).

Always plan your visit ahead of time. your visit. Wear proper gear and clothing, have plenty water, a flashlight, sun protection, and tell someone about your plans.

Leave No Trace. Pack out everything you pack in.



Pet Guidelines

BBC - Reminders!

Pet Guidelines

- Only two pets per home are allowed
- Fish tanks and bird cages count as one pet
 - No more than one fish tank is permitted in the home
 - No more than two bird cages are permitted in the home
- Exotic nor Farm animals are not permitted
- No visiting pets
- Pets must be registered on post and be vaccinated
- Pets are prohibited from any playground areas
- Breeding and raising animals in housing is prohibited
- Pets may be left in fenced- in-yards for short periods of time with proper food, water, and shelter
- Pets are not permitted to be chained/tethered outdoors and left unattended at any time
- Pets will not be permitted to run loose in the community
- Complaints concerning stray, unattended pets, or any general upkeep of housing areas should be reported to the community offices
