1. (U) <u>Situation.</u> 1st Armored Division and Fort Bliss will recognize outstanding Soldiers, Spouses, and Community Volunteers throughout the Fort Bliss community during a quarterly Volunteer Award Ceremony.

2. (U) <u>Mission.</u> 1st Armored Division and Fort Bliss will host a Quarterly Volunteer Awards Ceremony to recognize and thank Soldiers, Family Members, and Community Volunteers for their selfless service and to encourage others to volunteer their time and efforts within the community.

3. (U) Execution.

a. (U) <u>Commander's Intent.</u> Ensure that 1AD and Fort Bliss units are aware of the Fort Bliss Quarterly Volunteer Award Ceremony while recognizing the achievements of Soldiers, Spouses, and Community Volunteers and encourage community engagement and participation in volunteer programs.

(1) (U) <u>Purpose</u>. Recognize Fort Bliss volunteers and increase the visibility of volunteerism throughout the community.

(2) (U) Key Tasks.

(a) (U) BDE Commanders and Directors provide quarterly nominations from within their unit as the approving authority. This award is reserved for the Unit, Directorate, and Organizations top Volunteers of the Quarter (VOQ).

(b) (U) Request the 1AD Commanding General (CG) or his/her representative, to present recipients their awards at each quarterly ceremony.

(c) (U) Battalions, Directorates, and Private Organizations are responsible to use Enclosure 01 to submit quarterly VOQ nomination packets to the ACS POC for processing in accordance with the suspense for each quarter.

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(3) (U) <u>End State.</u> Conduct a safe and successful Quarterly Volunteer Awards Ceremony and recognize Soldiers, Spouses and Community Volunteers for their dedication and selfless service.

b. (U) Concept of Operations.

(1) (U) <u>Nominations.</u> Each Brigade submits three (3) nominations and separate Battalions, Directorates, and Private Organization submit one (1) nomination to the ACS POC in accordance with the suspense for each quarter to process certificates for signature from 1AD CG and Division Command Sergeant Major (DCSM). This phase concludes once nominations are provided for each quarter.

(2) (U) <u>VOQ Ceremony</u>. Begins at the start of the VOQ Ceremony at various Fort Bliss locations with the Family Resiliency Center (FRC), Bldg. 250 Club Road reserved as a backup. This phase ends at the conclusion of each ceremony.

(b) (U) 16 1300-1400 MAY 24, provide an O-6 level Commander to Host and be a Guest Speaker for VOQ ceremony. Provide names two (2) weeks prior to the ceremony to the ACS POC.

(3) (U) <u>2/1 AD.</u>

(a) (U) NLT the third Friday of the first month of each CY quarter, submit nominations for VOQ using *Appendix 1 (1AD and Fort Bliss Volunteer of the Quarter Nomination Form*) to the ACS POC.

(b) (U) On 11 1300-1400 JUL 24, provide an O-6 level Commander to Host and be a Guest Speaker for VOQ ceremony. Provide names two (2) weeks prior to the ceremony to the ACS POC.

(4) (U) <u>3/1 AD.</u>

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(a) (U) NLT the third Friday of the first month of each CY quarter, submit nominations for VOQ using *Appendix 1 (1AD and Fort Bliss Volunteer of the Quarter Nomination Form)* to the ACS POC.

(b) (U) On 15 1300-1400 FEB 24, provide a primary and alternate O-6 level Commander to Host and be a Guest Speaker for VOQ ceremony. Provide names two (2) weeks prior to the ceremony to the ACS POC.

(5) (U) <u>1AD CAB.</u>

(a) (U) NLT the third Friday of the first month of each CY quarter, submit nominations for VOQ using *Appendix 1 (1AD and Fort Bliss Volunteer of the Quarter Nomination Form)* to the ACS POC.

(b) (U) on 14 1300-1400 NOV 24, provide a primary and alternate O-6 level Commander to Host and be a Guest Speaker for VOQ ceremony. Provide names two (2) weeks prior to the ceremony to the ACS POC.
