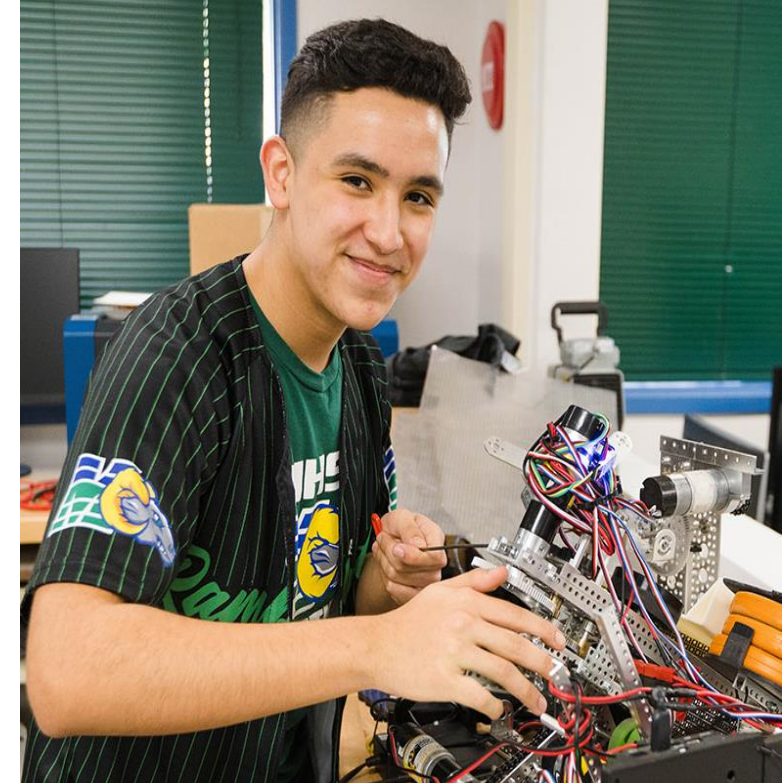

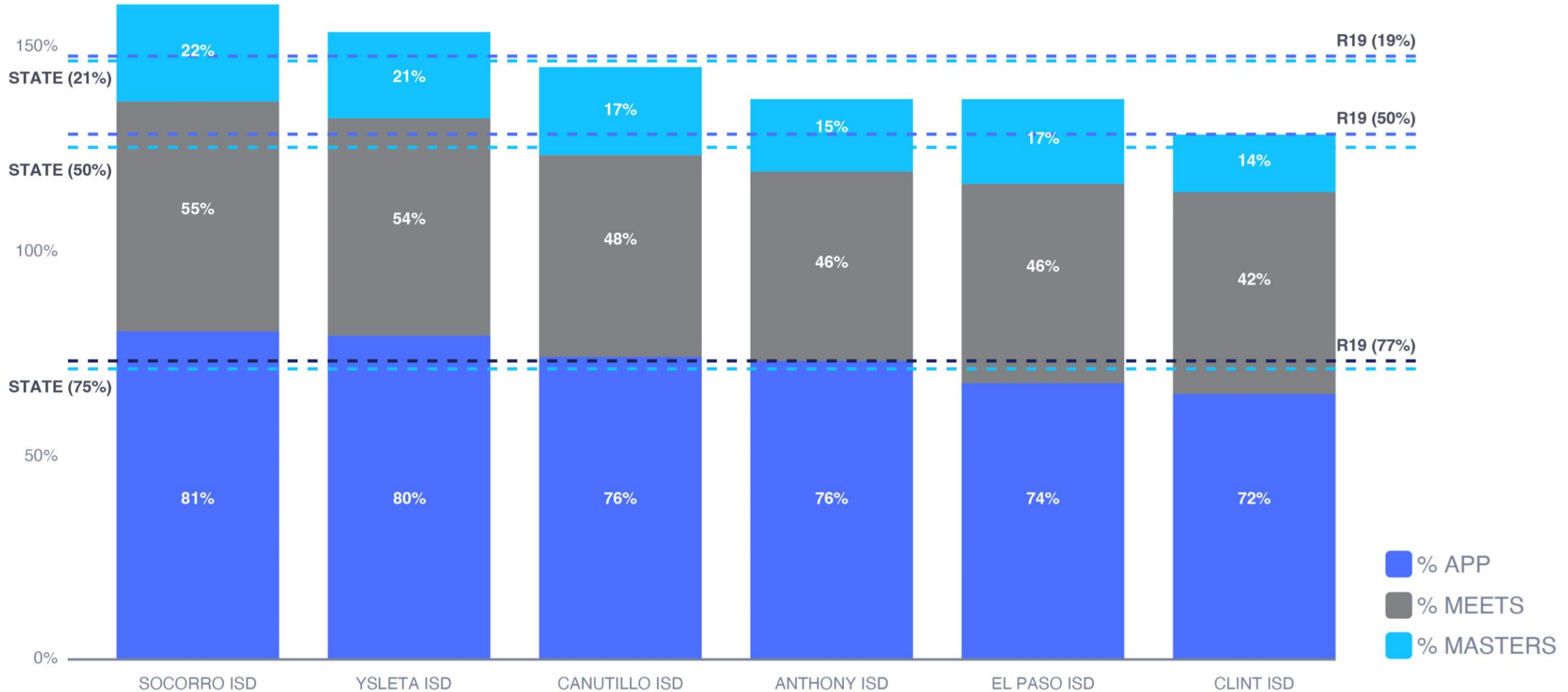

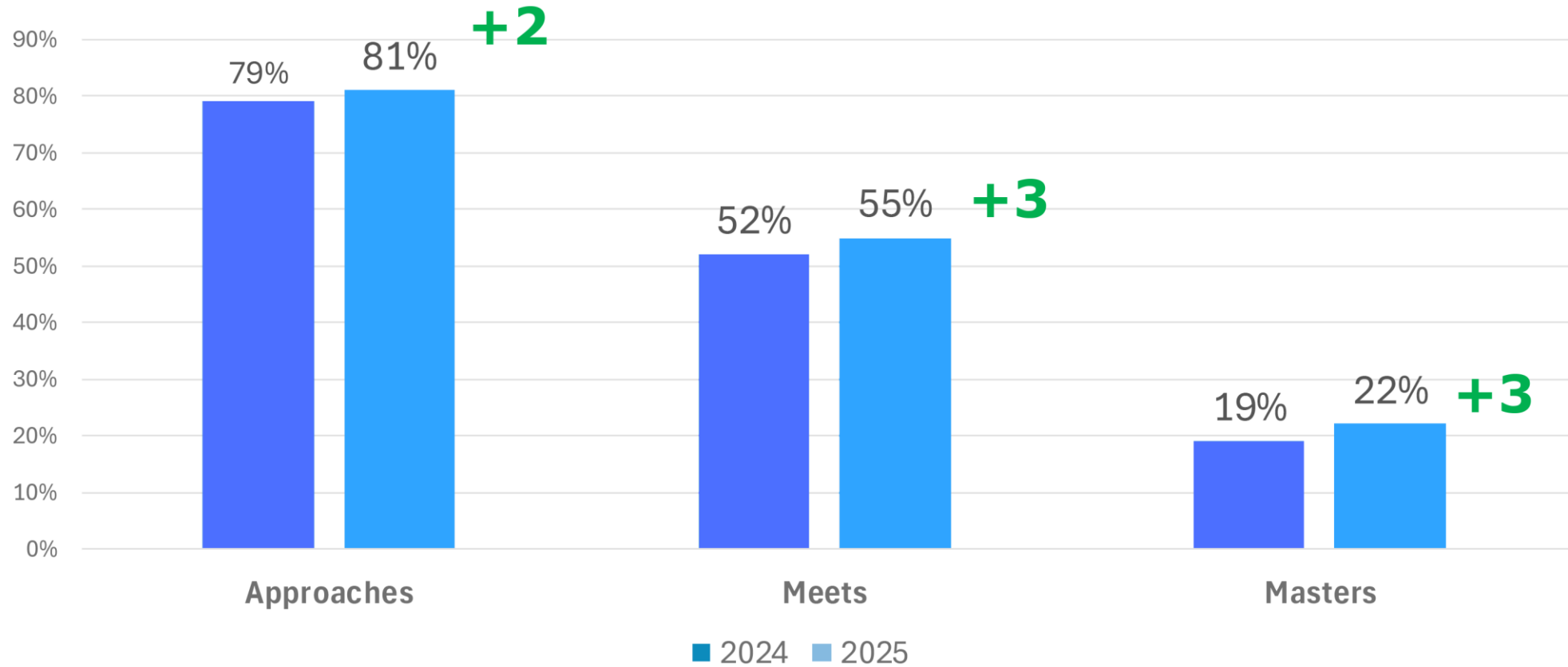


2025 STAAR Performance – Top 6 District

Socorro ISD identified as a regional and statewide model for educational excellence and college & career readiness at the Education Matters Summit (10/2/25)

What the Data Shows

- Nearly 900 students earned an associate degree while in high school (past 2yrs)
- 100% of 8th graders enrolled in Algebra I; 84% meeting grade-level standards
- District “Meets” performance increased from 55% to 67%
- Achievement gaps reduced to ~2x, compared to 3x–12x across Region 19
