




Repair Haan Rd from Sheridan to Overpass

Fort Bliss Tax Center

The Fort Bliss Tax Center has permanently closed.

Alternative Tax Preparation Sources:

- ✓ All Soldiers are strongly encouraged to use Military OneSource to prepare their taxes.

 Military OneSource is a confidential Department of Defense funded program that is both a call center and a website providing comprehensive information on every aspect of military life at no cost to Active Duty, Guard and Reserve Component members, their families and survivors. For more information, visit WWW.MILITARYONESOURCE.MIL/MILTAX-FREE-TAX-SERVICES.
- ✓ Individuals who are not eligible to use Military OneSource to prepare their taxes may use the free filing services provided by the IRS. Please keep in mind that these free filing services have certain income thresholds. For more information, visit https://www.irs.gov/Filing/FREE-File-Do-Your-FEDERAL-TAXES-FOR-FREE.
- ✓ TaxSlayer has a military offer that allows active-duty military to e-file a federal return for free. Please note that State returns have an additional cost. For more information, visit https://www.taxslayer.com/products/taxslayer-military?rdr=/products/discount-military-tax-filing.
- ✓ Qualified individuals can also get in-person support at a Volunteer Income Tax Support Assistance, or VITA, office location. For more information about VITA locations in the El Paso area, visit https://www.freetaxeselpaso.org/.
- ✓ Those who do not qualify for free filing will have to purchase a commercial tax preparation software or hire a commercial preparer to file their taxes.

NOTE: Although the Fort Bliss Legal Assistance Office will no longer provide tax preparation and filing services, it will continue to provide advice and assistance on certain tax issues, such as reviewing letters from the IRS or state tax authorities, as part of legal assistance. - > Reminders:
- Fort Bliss Blood Donor Center is in **DIRE NEED** of O positive & O negative blood types
- > The holiday season is a historically low collection time for our organization
 - > Fort Bliss Blood donor center is desperate for Command Support for blood drives
 - > PLEASE host a blood drive during block leave (Dec 20-22 & 27-29)
 - > We need at least 20 donor each of those days to make mission over the holiday season
 - We still need to support those troops who are conducting combat operations
 - > Troops who are away from their families during the holidays still need our support
- > Afghanistan and Korea (N. of Seoul) are now 3 month deferral instead of 12 months
- ASBP is still in need of Convalescent Plasma Donors (with confirmed positive test result)


