**ELIGIBLITY:** Active-duty military personnel, Army Reserve, and National Guard

service members in an active status assigned or attached to Fort

Bliss, with no more than 5 officiated bouts experience.

duty service members may register with the Sports Office located

at Soto Physical Fitness Center (PFC).

Weigh-ins and late registration will be conducted 25 July 2025 at

Stout PFC from 0900-1300. All forms including physical must be

turned at this time.

**REQUIRED FORMS:** 1. Sports Physical

2. Liability Waiver (signed by 1SG/CDR)

**COMPETITION** 

**FORMAT:** Each bout will consist of three 1-minute rounds, with 1-minute in

between rounds. Competitors will be matched based on weight

class.

**DIVISIONS:** MALE (11 Wt. Classes): 108lbs, 114lbs, 123lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs,

152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 201lbs, 201+lbs.

**FEMALE** (11 Wt. Classes): 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs,

141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 178+lbs.

**EQUIPMENT:** The MWR Sports Office will provide the following equipment:

1. Gloves

2. Headgear

3. Groin Protectors

4. Breast Protectors (for women)

- 6. Mouth Guards
- 7. Shirt & Shorts

**AWARDS:** 

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place individuals awards for each bout.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:** 

**Swearing and abusive remarks:** Whether directed towards opponents, team members, officials, fans or supervisors or indirect frustration about self-performance are behaviors which cast a negative atmosphere over intramural play and may lead to more serious problems.

Any contest may be forfeited by the administrator or official of the activity when a competitor or coach exhibits unsportsmanlike conduct or disruptive behavior during the contest. Competitors or coaches may be warned prior to forfeiting the contests. However, it will be at the discretion of the administrators to forfeit that contest if deemed necessary to avoid a violent confrontation. Competitors/Coaches ejected for a first offense may be suspended indefinitely from participating in sports activities, depending on the severity of the offense.

**ALCOHOL/TOBACCO:** 

Alcohol, smoking, vaping, or use of chewing tobacco is not permitted in the facility. Any competitor or coach under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted to enter the playing area.

**MEDICAL SUPPORT:** 

Medical coverage will be provided.

**COACHES MEETING:** 

A Coaches Meeting will be held on 23 July 2025 at 1800 hours at the Soldier Activity Center (SAC). This meeting is mandatory for coaches and participants. At that time all administrative procedures, rules, and safety will be discussed.
