



- One lane will always remain open during Construction (2 Phases).

Directorate of Public Works (DPW) Cassidy/Sheridan Intersection


- Start Construction November 12, 2024
- Phase I is 95% complete. Contractor is pending installation of landscape pavers. Paver installation will be completed as part of Phase III.
- Phase II completed on 13 FEB. Work consisted of asphalt, curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the Southwest corner of Cassidy & Sheridan.
- Phase III began on 17 FEB and work consists of asphalt, curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the Northeast corner of Cassidy & Sheridan
- Phase IV work will begin on 14 Mar and work consisted of asphalt, curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the Northwest corner of Cassidy & Sheridan.
- Phase V work will begin on 7 Apr. Work will be pavement markings and installation of bollards on the centerline of Cassidy.
- End Construction April 26, 2025.






