- FORSCOM Ride Share Pilot Program 1 March 1 June 2025.
 - To reduce delays, *reduce DWI's*, synergize access process, and develop standard across all installations.
- Uber Ride Share currently has 144 drivers, and 876 food deliveries who are vetted for installation access under this program and authorized 24/7 access.
- Geo-Fencing: Fort Bliss has provided geo-fencing information to Uber so that all calls received for on post pick up, or drop off, will receive a vetted driver reducing delays, or turn arounds at the ACPs.
- Silvestre-Reyes ACP closed, SGM Barreras ACP is now open 24/7
