THIS IS A PROJECT BY THE 34TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AND MADE POSSIBLE WITH A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

- El Paso County is ranked #7 out of top 10 Texas counties with highest DWI numbers.
- 34th Judicial District Attorney's (DA) Office received a grant from TXDOT to pay for UBER rides (thru Sep 2024) for persons out drinking.
- Active on Fridays-Mondays (0500 hrs).
- \$20 allotted for each ride (not counting tips).
- Average ride in El Paso costs \$14.
- Scan QR code to access DA's website.
- QR code is updated every Friday.
- **This initiative has provided over 1K rides since December 2023.**

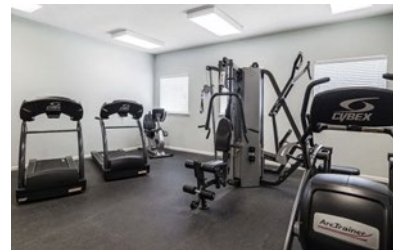
•Access Control Points:

- ✓ *Trusted traveler provides DoD sponsors the opportunity to bring additional patrons onto the installation; every occupant must show a valid form of identification.*
- ✓ *Special events passes can be granted online at the Fort Bliss homepage. Passes range from one day to one year Community Access Pass.*
- ✓ *Every day pedestrians cross the intersection at the Cassidy / Sheridan intersection, adjacent to Cassidy gate. Young schoolchildren regularly cross this intersection going to and from school. Normally the traffic light is green. When someone presses the crosswalk button, the traffic light turns red, and then the pedestrians can cross. However recently there have been multiple instances of drivers running the red light at this intersection.*
- ✓ *In some cases, these are inattentive drivers who are entering the installation; in other cases, it is outbound drivers who are exiting the installation. In every case, ignoring the red light creates an immediately hazardous situation for pedestrians, including children.*
- ✓ *In the immediate term, expect to see increased police patrol presence at this intersection to hold drivers accountable as appropriate. Over the longer term, our installation will implement further improvements to help enhance pedestrian safety, some of which will require time and resources to put in place.*






