



RANGE RULES

- Club members and their guests must sign in at the clubhouse Pro Shop prior to using ranges and must display club card at all time while on range.
- Non-members of the Club must sign in at the Clubhouse Pro Shop and obtain a range identification tag prior to using any range facility and must display their range tags at all times while on the range.
- Everyone is requested to adhere to the written Range Safety Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).
- Shooting targets may be purchased at the Clubhouse Pro Shop, and personal targets may be used if they meet the specific range requirements and Safety SOP. Plastic bottles, beer, and/or soft drink cans may be used as targets on range 8 only. Glass targets are not permitted on any ranges. The range must be cleaned prior to leaving.
- Please exercise caution not to accidentally discharge guns in the direction of club property, range signs, and stationary furniture.
- Alcohol, in any form, is not allowed on the ranges. Rod & Gun club personnel will refuse admittance to any range if an individual appears to be under the influence of alcohol.
- 50 caliber guns (of any type) & clay pigeon hand throwers are not allowed. Rifles with calibers capable of shooting over 4100 meters cannot be fired from any range. Due to Installation safety restrictions.
- Fully automatic guns are prohibited on any range at the Rod & Gun Club (with the exception of Federal Law Enforcement Qualification - requires prior management approval).
- Please only utilize the range you are assigned.
- All firing can only be done from the firing line, which are all painted red.
- Ear and eye protection will be worn by all shooters and spectators.
- As part of installation safety procedures all safety rules will be followed. You can review all rules in the Pro Shop.
- Please remove all pistol and rifle magazines and clear all guns before entering the clubhouse.
- All children under 18 must be under adult supervision at all times inside the Club and outside on the ranges. Any adult supervising a child will not be allowed to shoot on the ranges leaving the child unsupervised.
- Please help us keep our ranges clean! Pick up after yourself.

In the event of an Emergency, please follow these procedures:

- ***Cease Fire Immediately.***
- Push the emergency shut down system button located on the range.
- Notify the range safety officer.
- Follow all instructions given by the safety officer.
- Wait for the safety officer to lift the cease fire, and call ***"ALL CLEAR"***.



RANGE SAFETY RULES

- All guns will be pointed down range at all time.
 - As a precaution, always assume that the gun is loaded.
 - Keep your fingers off of the trigger until gun is ready to be fired.
 - All shooting will be done from the ready line or from behind the benches.
 - All shooters will use the words **"CLEAR"** and **"HOT"**.
 - Shooters needing to go down range will call **"CLEAR"**.
 - **"CLEAR"** means all guns are unloaded and not behind handled.
 - **"HOT"** means guns can be handled, loaded, and fired.
 - While shooter is downrange, no one is allowed to handle any guns.
 - When a shooter calls clear or hot he will get confirmation from all other shooters.
 - Only shoot at your target.
 - If anyone notices a violation of any of the above rules, they are responsible to call cease fire.
 - You are responsible for your own gun.
 - **Always be safe.**
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
