The Exchange is excited to announce the expansion of shopping privileges to additional DoD civilians and Coast Guard at Exchange stores in the United States and the U.S. territories and possessions. For verification of eligibility at Exchange stores in the United States and the U.S. territories and possessions, associates will need to check that the affiliation on the customer's CAC card indicates "Civilian" and the agency/department is "DoD" or a branch of Military Service. These individuals will only have Exchange shopping privileges at the installations where they are employed. Foreign country access remains unchanged.
