

**ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES FOR CONDUCTING
FORT BLISS – GOLF TOURNAMENT
18 – 20 November 2022**

1. **REFERENCES:** a. AR 215-1, Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities and, Morale, Welfare and Recreation Activities, 24 September 2010.
2. **WHAT:** Fort Bliss – Golf Tournament
3. **WHEN:** 18 November 2021//Start time – 1300
19 November 2021//Start time – 0900
20 November 2021//Start time - 0900
4. **WHERE:** General George V. Underwood, Jr. Golf Complex – 3200 Coe Ave, BLDG 3193
5. **ELIGIBILITY:**
 - a. Active-duty military personnel, Army Reserve, and National Guard Soldiers in an active status assigned or attached to Fort Bliss.
 - b. Each Brigade, as well as each member of the Independent League are authorized a maximum of eight players per roster. Players should be the best in their BDE/Battalion. A minimum of four players are required to be eligible for Commander's Cup Points. Each major command will conduct their own qualification to determine the best 8 players in their unit.
 - c. **Rosters will include name, rank of all players, and their average scores.** The designated team representative must provide their phone number and email address. **Rosters must be turned into the Sports Coordinator NLT 16 November 2022.** **Attendance at the coaches meeting is mandatory**, see below for date, time and location.
 - d. Military IDs will be checked against the roster. Lack of military ID will result in the player not being eligible to play in the tournament.
6. **MEETING:** A pre-tournament coaches meeting will be held on **9 NOV 2022, General George V. Underwood, Jr. Golf Complex at 1800.** The clinic is mandatory for all team representatives.
7. **TOURNAMENT PLAY:**
 - a. Play will be governed by USGA Rules of Competition and local rules.
 - b. The tournament will be stroke play with the exception of a maximum of 9 strokes per any given hole.

c. For team competition, the best four scores per day will count for team total.

8. **EQUIPMENT:**

a. Players must wear proper attire and provide their own equipment.

b. Players, if they elect to get a car, will be responsible for cart rental fee.

c. Green fees will be paid by the Fort Bliss Sports Office.

9. **PROTESTS:**

A protest concerning **eligibility** must be submitted in writing to the League Coordinator prior to the end of the tournament.

10. **SPORTSMANSHIP:**

Swearing and abusive remarks directed towards opponents, officials, fans or supervisors are behaviors which casts a negative atmosphere over intramural play and may lead to more serious problems. Tournament Director will penalize such behavior and all cussing with an ejection from the tournament.

11. **DRINKING/SMOKING/
CHEWING TOBACCO:**

Alcohol, smoking, vaping, or use of chewing tobacco is **NOT** permitted on the playing area or in the facility parking lot. Any player under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted to enter the playing area.

12. **AWARDS:**

Team and individual awards will be awarded to the top two teams.
Individual award for lowest score.
Individual award for longest drive.
Individual award for closest to the hole.

13. **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

During golf play, the captain is responsible for ensuring that:

- (1) All members of the team are familiar with the contents of this MOI.
- (2) The team is fully equipped and properly attired.
- (3) The conduct of the team is in accordance with this MOI.
- (4) No illegal players are entered on roster or participate in games.
